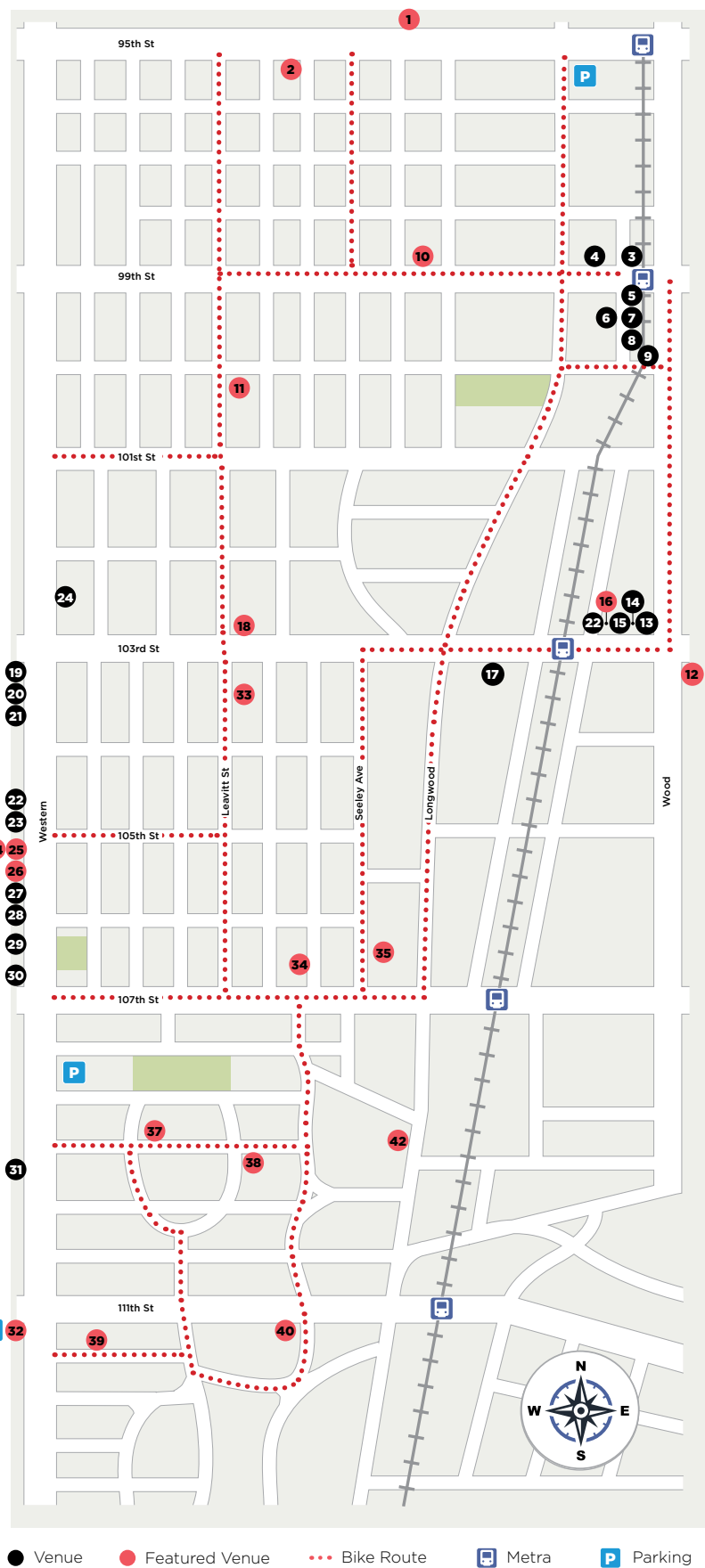


BEVERLY ART WALK

The 10th Annual Beverly Art Walk is a celebration of art and music, showcasing a diverse array of unique cultural assets, local artists' home studios, and art environments across Beverly/Morgan Park. The free, family-friendly event features nearly 200 artists in 40 venues, the popular Uprising Craft Market—at 103rd & Wood Street—the Family Fun Park at Sutherland in conjunction with Sutherland's I Madonnari street painting festival, live music, and public art activations.
